COMMUNITY EXHIBITS PROGRAM AT QUEEN'S PARK

The Museums of Prince Edward County are heading off to the Legislative Assembly of Ontario at Queen's Park in Toronto! From March to September 2010, we will be participating in the Community Exhibits Program. This unique program provides an opportunity for Ontario museums to present unique stories from their community. At Queen's Park, the Museums of Prince Edward County will be presenting an exhibit titled, "The Garden County," which will tell the story of the canning industry in the County. Examples of County canning industry labels from the Douglas A. Crawford Canning Industry Collection at the Wellington Heritage Museum will be exhibited to tell the story of this important period in County history.
