



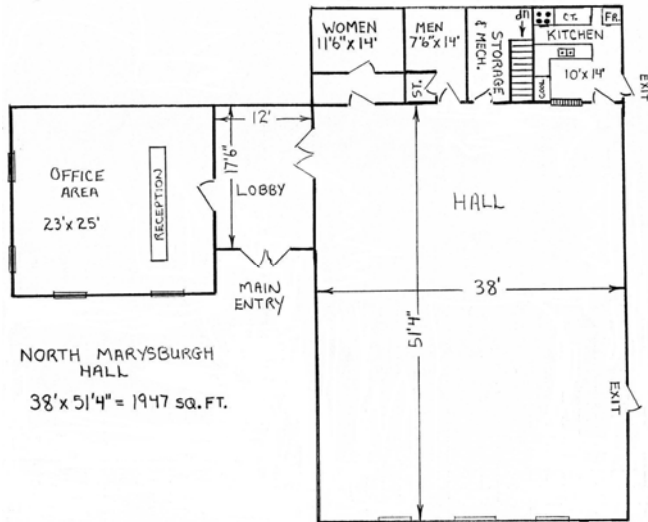

History of North Marysburgh Town Hall

Opened in 1995, this building is the newest municipal building in the County. It was opened as the Township municipal office as well as a multi-purpose community hall. Following amalgamation in 1998, the municipal office has been renovated into a meeting space and large kitchen area.

This hall is used regularly for dances and concerts including the North Marysburgh Recreation Committee Circle of Song.
