



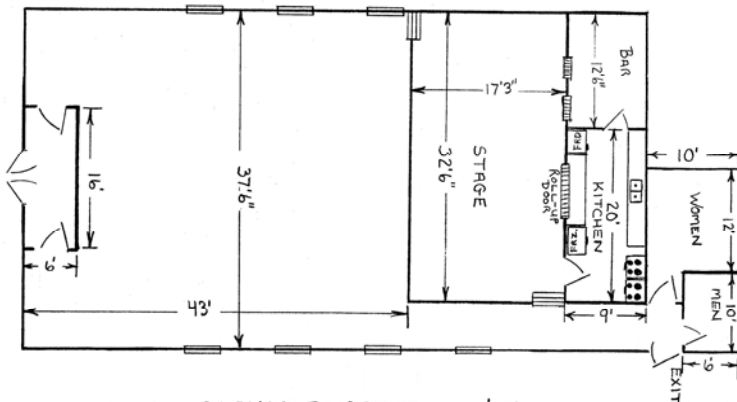

**History of Sophiasburgh Town Hall**

Along with Friendship United Church, the Sophiasburgh Town Hall has been an integral part of the community life in Demorestville for many years. The Sophiasburgh Town Hall was constructed in 1875 by James Spurr of Hillier at a cost of \$4,400.

**Sophiasburgh Town Hall Today**

With the rich interior finishing of wood floors, wainscoting and fabric curtains the Sophiasburgh Hall is a great location for various community events and theatrical events. Many community theatre groups have rehearsed and hosted events in this hall utilizing the large stage area. The Hall is a community focal point hosting the Sophiasburgh Winter Carnival and the Sophiasburgh Recreation Committee Dinner Theatre event with the Regent Theatre Young Company.
