The Program

- Will recognize achievements from January 1st, 2000 onwards.
- Will be ongoing throughout the year to coincide with the achievement.
- Will recognize each recipient at a regular Council meeting.
- Will install each recipient in the County of Prince Edward Civic Recognition “Honour Book” to be on display at Shire Hall.

The Process

- Nomination forms are available at the Community Services Department, 6 Ross St. Picton, Ontario (613- 476-1159).
- A Nomination form must be completed and submitted to the Community Services Department.
- The Nomination will be put on the agenda for the next regular meeting of the Community Services Committee.
- IF the Community Services Committee determine the Nominee(s) to fit within the criteria, a Recognition Ceremony will take place at the next regular meeting of County Council.
