Please respect other people’s property, don’t walk on lawns and gardens. Ensure you are only taking an item marked “FREE” and please do not discard previously picked up treasures on another person’s property.

Please consider safety when deciding which items to give away. The Consumer Product Safety Bureau of Heath Canada advises that used children’s items such as baby walkers, cribs, stroller’s, playpens, car seats, mattresses, blinds and other child related items should not be placed out at the curb as they may not comply with current safety regulations.
