June 9, 2011 Boil Water Advisory has been lifted for the Ameliasburgh Drinking Water System

Dear Valued Water Customer,

Please be advised that the Boil Water Advisory issued by the Medical Officer of Health on June 9, 2011 has been lifted as of June 14, 2011. Water samples collected on June 9, 2011 from the Ameliasburgh Water Treatment Facility and Distribution System indicate that the water is safe for use and free from bacterial contamination. Please see the official statement from the Hastings and Prince Edward Counties Health Unit on the reverse side of this notification.

As a measure to ensure your household is receiving the best possible water quality, you may choose to flush the plumbing in your home. To do this, allow cold water to run through your faucet for at least five minutes before use. In addition, other faucets in your home can be flushed for a ten second period before use. This will ensure that any stagnant water in your plumbing is expelled and fresh water is received for your consumption and other household uses.
