County Road 21 will be closed to vehicle traffic on October 05 & 06, 2009 to permit the replacement of a large drainage culvert. The Information Centre is being held to explain the project and the arrangements which the County will have in place to address the needs and requirements of the residents of Big Island during the road closure. Issues such as public transportation, medical assistance, fire and police protection will be explained.

COUNTY ROAD 21 CLOSURE

Monday, October 05 & Tuesday, October 06, 2009

- **Road will be closed to vehicle traffic beginning at 6:00 a.m. on October 05.**
- **A pedestrian walkway will be in place at all times to bypass the construction site.**
- **A parking area will be provided for vehicle parking at the Demorestville Public Works yard. Residents are encouraged to park at this location. A 24 hour shuttle taxi service will be provided on both sides of the road closure for either pickup from your residence and transportation via the pedestrian walkway to your vehicle at Demorestville or return.**

Taxi service for students on Big Island will be available at the usual time and place. Taxi Service will deliver students to their regular school bus at the intersection of County Roads 21 & 15. A return service will be provided in the afternoon.
