



NOTICE OF BY-LAW RETAIL BUSINESS HOLIDAYS ACT

The County of Prince Edward has adopted By-law 2611-2010 under the Retail Business Holidays Act, to add Good Friday as one of the Statutory Holidays that retail businesses may be open to the public. Retail businesses are currently permitted to open on Easter Sunday, Victoria Day, Canada Day, Labour Day and Thanksgiving Day.

Any person may appeal By-law 2611-2010 by filing a notice of appeal with the Ontario Municipal Board setting out the objection to the by-law and the reason in support of the objection no later than May 28, 2010.

If there are no objections filed with the Ontario Municipal Board, By-law 2611-2010 will come into force and effect on 29th day of May, 2010.
