

Notice of Study Completion of an Environmental Screening and Review under the Ontario Electricity Projects Regulation (O.Reg. 116/01)

Byran Wind Project near Picton, Ontario

SkyPower Corp. (SkyPower) has completed an Environmental Screening and Review (ESR), as required under the Ontario Regulation 116/01 of the Environmental Assessment Act, for the proposed development, construction, and commissioning of a wind energy project near Picton, Ontario, referred to as the Byran Wind Project.

The Project, located in the Sophiasburgh and Hallowell Wards of Prince Edward County, is expected to have an overall nameplate capacity 64.5 MW. SkyPower is undertaking this project in response to the Ontario Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure's mandate to procure 2700 MW of renewable energy power generation. The Project area is generally located south and west of Foster Road, north of County Road 1 and south of the Bay of Quinte (please see map).

SkyPower commenced the Ontario ESR Process for Electricity Projects in September 2008 and published a "Notice of Study Commencement of Environmental Screening and Review" on September 26, 2008. Jacques Whitford Stantec Limited (Stantec) carried out the ESR for this Project.

The ESR assesses the impact of the Project on the biophysical and socio-economic environment during construction, operation and decommissioning phases and examines, among other matters, the potential for effects on plants, birds and wildlife, and the potential for noise, visual, social and economic effects. Public and agency input was considered as part of this assessment. Based on the ESR results, SkyPower does not anticipate any significant adverse effects to the environment during the construction, operations or decommissioning phases of the Project. Therefore, SkyPower intends to proceed with the Project subject to mitigation and impact management measures, and other approvals described in the ESR.

The Environmental Review Report prepared during the ESR process is available for review by the public and any interested parties as of **Tuesday, August 25, 2009** for a 30 day review period (August 25, 2009 to September 24, 2009), and can be reviewed at the following locations:

The Environmental Review Report and supporting information are also available on SkyPower's website www.byranwindproject.com. Any outstanding environmental concerns about the Project should be raised with SkyPower during the public review period. SkyPower is committed to resolving concerns to the best of its ability.

If SkyPower and the concerned party are unable to resolve the matter, the concerned party may make a written request to the Director of the Environmental Assessment and Approvals Branch of the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) to elevate the project to an Individual Environmental Assessment. An elevation request must be made in accordance with the provisions set out in the MOE's Environmental Screening Process which is described in the EA Guide (available online at <http://www.ene.gov.on.ca/envision/gp/4021e.pdf>).

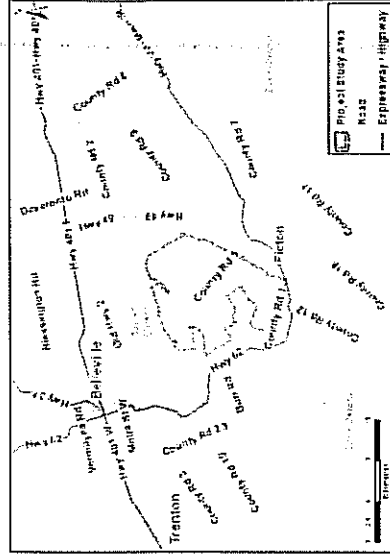
