THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD

By-Law No. -2011

A By-law to Amend By-law No. 1122-2003, being a by-law to regulate signs and other advertising devices in the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward

WHEREAS Council wishes to clarify its intent concerning the applicability of By-law No. 1122-2003;

AND WHEREAS it was never the intent of Council to have the provisions of By-law No. 1122-2003 to apply to the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward;

AND WHEREAS the municipality has developed policies in the interest of the public for the installation of signs along highways, road allowances, municipal properties and other locations;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward enacts as follows:

1. By-law No. 1122-2003, being a by-law to regulate signs and other advertising devices in the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward, shall be amended as follows:
 - a) the following shall be inserted to follow Section 2 of By-law No. 1122-2003:

“2(a) Municipal Exemption
Despite Section 2, the provisions of this By-law do not apply to signs placed or installed by or at the direction of the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward on property owned by the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward, including public highways.”
2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately on the date of passing.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this day of 2011.
